Class Description/Goals/Objectives:

- This class is a directed study period for students with an IEP.
- Students will organize and complete their work with support from a CLC teacher.
- Students will take personal responsibility to use class time for assignment completion and skill improvement.
- Students will learn to advocate for their accommodations and modifications.
- Students will learn to facilitate their achievement by asking their CLC teacher to help them communicate with general education teachers.

Instructional Materials Used:

- Students will bring their necessary textbooks, reading materials, binder, notebook, folders, pen/pencil, and other materials needed to complete their assignments.
- Teacher will provide a CLC folder that includes an assignment log and a work log for students to complete during each class.

Class Expectations and Evaluation/Grading System:

Students will be scored daily on EACH of the following expectations:

- Arrive on time
 1. Students are marked tardy when they are not in the room when the bell rings
 2. Ten unverified tardies is equal to one unexcused absence
 - Work the entire period
 - Allow others to work
 - Write daily homework assignments on assignment sheet or in planner
 - Complete daily CLC work log
- For example, at one point for each expectation per day, students can earn 25 points per week:
21-25 points = A 16-20 points = B 11-15 points = C 6-10 points = D 1-5 points = F

Class Rules:

- Computers are for schoolwork assistance only
- Cell phones are not allowed
- Use of radios is by permission only. If you are listening to music but not working, you will be told to turn it off. Failure to do so will result in a referral to OCI.
- Hall passes are not allowed during the first or last 10 minutes of class. No exceptions.
- Positive behavior is always rewarded!
